Preschool Overview

Willamette Christian School's preschool has served families in Lane County since 1941 by providing a quality preschool program for 3 to 5 year old children. The program is licensed through the Oregon Childcare Division. The preschool program offers a variety of schedules to choose from, offering care as early as 7:30 AM and as late as 6:00 PM.

We cultivate a safe and secure atmosphere of respect and an appreciation of the wonders of God's world. At the school, children can work, play, and discover together in a happy and wholesome environment. The classroom activities include: circle time, language and math readiness activities, music, art and craft projects, exploration of science and nature, Christian education and values, story time, and an introduction to various countries and cultures.

We encourage the total development of each child by providing experiences of lasting value:

SPIRITUALLY: Developing an understanding of God's character in everyday activities through Bible stories, songs, scripture memorization, and prayer. Problem solving is handled by using Biblical principles.

INTELLECTUALLY: Encouraging an enthusiasm for learning, exploring, and "hands on" experiences. We emphasize letter recognition and phonics as well as math readiness skills. Our preschool classes are excellent preparation for our Kindergarten classes. ***The extent of preparation your child has for Kindergarten will partially depend on the class schedule that they are enrolled in.***

PHYSICALLY: Providing opportunities to develop both the large and small muscle coordination and motor skills. Our playground, indoor recess area, and classroom activities provide a wide array of opportunities for large muscle development. Each classroom has many manipulative toys and activities available daily for small muscle development.

SOCIALLY: Enabling students to participate in group activities that develop communication, cooperation, and problem solving skills. Children at this age are just beginning to develop 'special' friendships and are ready to begin the process of learning to work and play together. Learning to be a good friend and class mate will be an important goal. Play time is a very important part of our preschool experience.

Being part of Willamette Christian School gives our preschool classes' access to the wonderful school campus and many special activities (chapel, music class and special music programs, science fair, assemblies, hot lunch program, and special holiday celebrations).
